CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE SENECA-CAYUGA NATION SECRETARIAL ELECTION CERTIFICATE OF RESULTS OF ELECTION

Under a Secretarial election authorized by Jessie Durham, Acting Regional Director, Eastern Oklahoma Region, Bureau of Indian Affairs, on August 29, 2019, the attached amendments, designated as Proposed Amendment A - First of Three amendments, Proposed Amendment B -Second of Three amendments and Proposed Amendment C - Third of Three amendments, to the Constitution and By-laws of the Seneca-Cayuga Nation, were submitted to the Registered Voters of the Tribe on November 14, 2019. Proposed Amendment A - First of Three amendments was duly rejected by a vote of $\underline{283}$ for and $\underline{386}$ against and $\underline{1}$ cast ballots found spoiled in an election in which at least 30 percent of the 969 Registered Voters cast their ballot in accordance with Section 3 of the Oklahoma Indian Welfare Act of June 26, 1936 (49 Stat. 1967), as amended. Proposed Amendment B - Second of Three amendments was duly rejected by a vote of $\underline{273}$ for and $\underline{396}$ against and $\underline{0}$ cast ballots found spoiled in an election in which at least 30 percent of the 969 Registered Voters cast their ballot in accordance with Section 3 of the Oklahoma Indian Welfare Act of June 26, 1936 (49 Stat. 1967), as amended. Proposed Amendment C - Third of Three amendments was duly rejected by a vote of $\underline{257}$ for and $\underline{412}$ against and $\underline{0}$ cast ballots found spoiled in an election in which at least 30 percent of the 969 Registered Voters cast their ballot in accordance with Section 3 of the Oklahoma Indian Welfare Act of June 26, 1936 (49 Stat. 1967), as amended.
